Creighton Elementary School District offers screenings for preschool children ages 3-5 (not enrolled in Kindergarten). The purpose of the screening is to identify children with potential delays in development. Early identification provides children with early educational services. The district provides a developmental preschool for children with developmental delays and/or disabilities.

Your child will be observed and/or screened in the following areas to see if delays exist:

- Speech-Language/ Communication
 - Cognition/ Academics
 - Social-Emotional
 - Daily Living Skills
 - Motor Skills
 - *Vision & Hearing
